Phase II

Based on feedback from users enhancements have been made to STAR-QI.

The application is now in Phase II



Phase II Enhancements:

1. Additional flex items (3 and 4) and a 3rd assessment date
2. New Indicator Reports
3. New Data monitoring and Quality Reports
4. Expanded Export Functionality
5. Enhanced Report Functionality (ability to overlay similar reports and report on subsets based on flex items)

Details of Enhancements

1. Additional flex items (3 and 4) and a 3rd assessment date:

- Three new data entry items have been added to the STAR-QI Episode tab for searching and for data entry: **Assessment Date 3**, **Flex Item 3**, and **Flex Item 4** (apostrophes and commas are no longer allowed in flex item values).
- Each flex item (1 through 4) is now available in a multiple selection listing for searching or as a selection item for data entry
- To aid data quality in flex items, the system will run a procedure on a nightly basis to remove values from the flex item lists if those items are no longer used.

2. New Indicator Reports have been added as follows:

ER-6a	Number of Clients Currently in Treatment for 1 Month or More
ER-9	Number of Clients Currently in Treatment for 3 Months or More
ER-10	Percent of Admissions currently in Treatment for 1 Month or More
ER-11	Percent of Admissions currently in Treatment for 2 Months or More
ER-12	Percent of Admissions currently in Treatment for 3 Months or More
ER-13	Percent of Admissions currently in Treatment for 6 Months or More
ER-14	Percent of Admissions with Length of Stay (LOS) or Length of Treatment (LOT) of 1 Month or more
ER-15	Percent of Admissions with Length of Stay (LOS) or Length of Treatment (LOT) of 2 Months or more
ER-16	Percent of Admissions with Length of Stay (LOS) or Length of Treatment (LOT) of 3 Months or more
ER-17	Percent of Admissions with Length of Stay (LOS) or Length of Treatment (LOT) of 6 Months or more

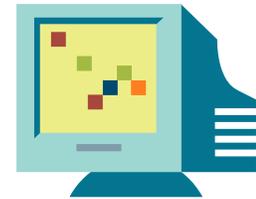

3. New Data monitoring and Quality Reports:

- New data monitoring and quality control reports are now included on the main Applications Tab under a new ‘STAR-QI Reports’ section.
- The Performance summary section includes a Summary Report showing three categories: Activity, Data Quality, and Missing Data. Each category shows a list of criteria with a total number of episode records for each criterion. Hints and recommendations for further reports that can be run are shown where appropriate.
- The Data Quality section includes reports that show Client Tracking ID and date data in CDS that do not exist or do not match in STAR-QI.
- The Missing Data section includes reports that show a list of episode details for episode records that require additional input.
- The Summary Report can be run as needed and e-mailed monthly to the STAR-QI contact at each organization.

4. Expanded Export Functionality

- The entire query results are exported to excel with a default .XLS extension for ease of use.



5. Enhanced Report Functionality (ability to overlay similar reports and report on subsets based on flex items)

- Indicator Reports tab now allows you to specify report output as indicator overlays or flex item combinations as well as to filter the results using flex items or discharge status values.
